



Beaches songwriter Finn Twist has recorded a Christmas song with locals from the Sydney Boys' Choir.

Northern Beaches based music producer, Finn Twist, has collaborated with 10 local vocalists from the Sydney Boys' Choir to record his latest Christmas song *My Hometown*.

With the nostalgia of a Christmas classic, *My Hometown* tells the nativity story through the eyes of a poor child of Bethlehem, who, along with the rest of the town's children, honours the baby

Jesus by performing a song for him.

"To me it feels like *My Hometown* has always been around, but only just discovered, which is very satisfying as a songwriter," Finn says.

"Eventually it became clear that it wanted to be a Christmas carol."

Despite some of the boys having no recording experience and Finn having never tackled a recording project like this before, the songwriter says all the vocalists acted as professionals.

My Hometown from Finn Twist and Sydney Boys' Choir will be available on all major streaming and download services, and at finntwist.com, in early December.
